



## Summer Camp Internship 2017

**Description:**

Sacramento Children's Museum's (SCM) Summer Camp Internship is a wonderful opportunity to help develop and lead day camps for children ages 4-11 years old. A qualified candidate should be experienced, creative, and enthusiastic about working with young children and their families.

SCM Summer Camp Interns will work alongside our Education Team to plan and facilitate camp activities. There also will be preparation time required the weeks before each camp for activity planning.

Three camps will be held at Hagan Community Center in Rancho Cordova:

- Cooking Around the World Camp: June 5-9, 2017 – 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- Art Studio Camp: June 19-23, 2017 – 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- From Book to Table Camp: June 26-30, 2017 – 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Two camps will be held at the Sacramento Children's Museum in Rancho Cordova:

- STEM Lab Camp: July 17-21, 2017 – 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- Creative Art Camp: August 21-25, 2017 – 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

**Internship duties include:**

- Help plan camp activities and curriculum;
- Greet and welcome campers;
- Assist with camp set-up and clean-up;
- Help administer camp programs and activities;
- Interact with campers and assist them with a variety of tasks as needed; and
- Assist the Education Team, as needed.

**Requirements:**

- Demonstrated experience working with children ages 4-11 in classrooms, recreational settings, and/or after school programs;
- Excellent communication skills and ability to interact positively with children, adults, and large groups from diverse backgrounds;
- Background in Early Childhood Education, Child Development, or related field preferred; and
- Must be comfortable with being responsible for a broad variety of tasks.
