Sacramento Children's Museum Receives Over \$7,000 Grant from Bayer Fund

Donation to help bring STEM workshops to under-resourced elementary schools

Sacramento, CA – The Sacramento Children's Museum announced today it received a grant for over \$7,000 from Bayer Fund, a philanthropic arm of Bayer in the U.S. This grant will be used towards building a better future by bringing hands-on STEM educational workshops to students in Grades 1-3 at under-resourced elementary schools in Woodland, CA, at no cost to the schools. The program will be facilitated through Van Go, the organization's mobile museum program.

The Sacramento Children's Museum (SCM) was incorporated as a non-profit corporation in 2005. SCM seeks to build an environment in which learning is exciting and enriching for children and their families and facilitated through exploration and hands-on activities. Built by Roebbelen Contracting, Inc., the Museum opened to the public on August 25, 2011. In 2021, the museum expanded to include the entire original building thanks to a donation from the City of Rancho Cordova. The expansion increased storage, classroom and office space and added 3,000 square feet of exhibit space, which has hosted traveling exhibits and Leo's Learning Lab. With the regular addition of new hands-on experiences, programs and activities, SCM aims to inspire all children through play-based learning.
